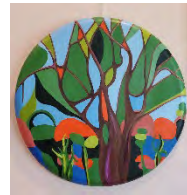

All Pen Women are invited to participate in the “Visions of Women” exhibit at the Sunrise Gallery. The show will run from April 21st through May 30th.

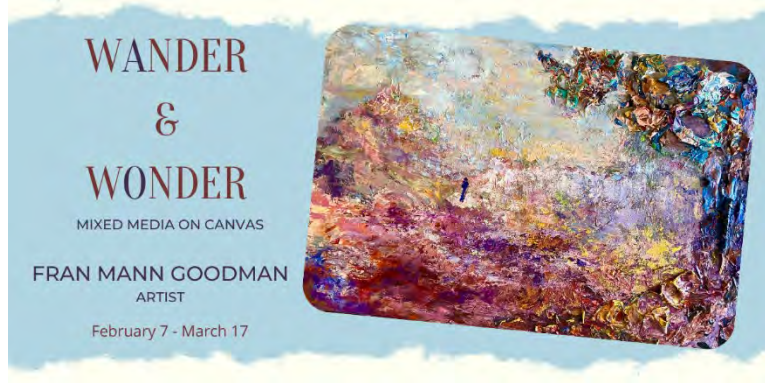
